MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID

Offered on behalf of the Mental Health Commision of Canada

This two-day course gives participants the skills to provide assistance to a person developing a mental health issue or experiencing a mental health crisis; just as physical first aid is administered to an injured person before medical treatment can be offered or until the crisis is resolved.

**Participants must be present for the full length of the course in order to be certified.

RETURN TO WORK 101 (optional)

The objective of this course is to provide participants with the tools to develop strategies to assist workers with disabilities and return them to long-term healthy and productive employment. The course will review noteworthy case law and Human Rights legislation.

Who should attend: Anyone in a role with whom workers make contact following a workplace injury or with disability accommodation requests: workers, employers, union reps, stewards, supervisors.
