

WORKERS' COMPENSATION 101

A comprehensive overview of key components of Workers'
Compensation. This one-day course will provide participants with an introduction to workers' compensation legislation and policies, benefits and services, and obligations for injury reporting and return to work participation.

RETURN TO WORK 101

This course provides participants with tools to develop strategies to assist workers with disabilities, individually and collectively; and return them to long-term healthy and productive employment. It will review noteworthy case law and Human Rights legislation.
